Environmental policy

JCA recognises that its activities may have a direct or indirect effect on the local, regional and global environment.

We are committed to improving environmental performance across all our events and activities, and encourage our users and hirers to join us in this effort.

Purchasing

All purchasing decisions – from cleaning products and paper products, to furniture and equipment – take account of environmental factors and the impact of different options, from their production to their use, through to disposal.

Wherever possible we buy recycled and upcycled products and aim to avoid wherever possible the purchase and use of single-use plastics, and non-recyclable products.

We buy locally produced goods wherever possible, including food, and encourage our hall users and hirers to do the same.

Energy and water saving

The hall's design incorporated the results of an Ecological Sustainability report, which resulted in the installation of a ground-source heat pump and solar panels.

We use low energy light bulbs and sensor-controlled switches or timers wherever appropriate, and avoid leaving lights or appliances switched on when they are not needed.

Regular checks for leaky taps, pipes and toilets are part of our regular maintenance checks.
